# SCHOOL QUALITY ASSURANCE

Our School Quality Assurance program reached new heights in 2020 as our scope expanded, our team grew, and systems were refined. Below are a few of the major highlights that showcase P4H Global's reach in Haiti through training educators on student-centered strategies.

100 PARTNER SCHOOLS

1,500 TEACHERS

67,000 STUDENTS

In response to COVID-19 restrictions, we developed a DISTANCE COACHING program. The program, conducted through PLCs (Professional Learning Communities on Whatsapp), now integrates targeted support to meet the needs of each individual teacher. Our coaches engage with each teacher on a weekly basis to support their professional growth. From videos, to phone calls, to text, teachers are receiving resources that will impact student success on their mobile devices.





# **IMPACT TRIPS**

Although COVID drastically interrupted our regularly scheduled Impact Trips, we were able to conduct two successful trips during the early parts of the year. A team of 14 individuals traveled to Nicaragua and 39 individuals traveled to Haiti. These groups developed three days worth of workshop content to be presented to the local community.

The teams focused on mental, men's, women's, and dietary health, business strategies, English lessons, and kid's leadership programs. Our Impact Trip members came back with a deeper understanding of sustainable development, intercultural communication, and social justice issues.

92% of participants increased their knowledge of effective aid practices before and at the end of the trip.

85% of trip members increased their understanding of economic poverty.

# GLOBAL PROGRAMS

## **P4H MASTER CLASS**

With adversity comes innovation. When we realized that our Impact Trips were to be indefinitely postponed, we knew we would have to pivot. We wanted to continue empowering others with a greater understanding of sustainable development, as usually happens on our Impact Trips, while doing so in a safe and "socially distanced" manner.

We believe that education is the primary vehicle to create lasting change, and as a result we created a P4H Master Class to continue our vision of training people to transform nations.

2020 was an unprecedented year that brought new challenges and unexpected growth in our Haiti programs. The next pages highlight the growth we've seen in people, programs and partnerships.

## **PEOPLE**

Our team doubled from 14 to 30 full-time staff members in Haiti.

We increased our team's expertise with 12 specialized trainings from experts around the globe.

Lovenie Mérélus was promoted, becoming P4H's **1st female director in Haiti**.

We hired our **5th** full-time U.S. staff member, Grace Reyes, who brings with her 20 years of instructional coaching experience.

## **PROGRAMS**

Teachers began our program with an average pre-test score of 42%, but ended the first year of training with a 94% post-test score.

Overall, 96% of teachers in our program received higher classroom observation scores in their follow-up observations.

P4H is officially training **in all 10** of Haiti's Departments.

# **PARTNERSHIPS**

#### **Food for the Poor**

FFP, one of the largest NGOs in America, partnered with P4H in 2020 to scale impact and reach 600 Haitian teachers.

#### **Digicel Foundation**

The Digicel Foundation, the largest telecommunications company in the Caribbean, outsourced their entire education department to P4H.

#### **Ministry of Education (MENFP)**

MENFP partnered with P4H to train teachers in 7 public schools in the North Department.

#### **University of Konstanz in Germany**

University of Konstanz, a leading university in Germany, selected P4H to conduct a specialized training on corporal punishment to community and public schools.

#### Inter-American Development Bank (IADB)

The IADB funded P4H's School Quality
Assurance Program in public schools in Haiti.



# P4H FINANCES



We know that in order to have a long term impact, our nonprofit must be built to last financially, and this past year was proof that P4H will continue to make a global impact for years to come. Even with COVID-19, our revenue grew **63% over the previous year.** 2020 was the 3rd year in a row of growing by more than 50% over the previous year.
